Conference on Development Economics

Nääs Fabriker, Gothenburg 22-23 November, 2021

Third time lucky? We sincerely hope that this time we will finally be able to meet!

The sixth ASWEDE* conference on Development Economics will take place at <u>Nääs Fabriker</u>, in a beautiful location just outside of Gothenburg. ASWEDE promotes scientific research in development economics through workshops and conferences, and supports cooperation between development economists active in Sweden. The conference is open to development economists active in and outside of Sweden.

We now invite submissions for the ASWEDE conference from researchers and PhD students on any topic within the area of Development Economics. <u>The deadline for submission is September</u> 27, 2021.

The conference starts at 11 am on Monday November 22 and ends in the afternoon of Tuesday November 23. To encourage an interactive conference, the program will contain a mix of shorter and longer presentations; open both to graduate students and senior researchers. The shorter presentations can include a brief discussion of new ideas, getting feedback on survey design, or more developed papers. While conference attendance is not conditional on presenting, we strongly encourage participants to present some work, even if very preliminary.

Participants interested in presenting in the longer sessions should submit full papers while an abstract is sufficient to signal an interest in the shorter slots. All submissions as well as the intent to participate should be sent to conference2021@aswede.org

Due to current Covid-restrictions (subject to change), the conference may have to accept a maximum of 50 participants. Priority will be given to presenters, but depending on the number of submissions, there may be room for additional participants. If interested in participating without presenting, please send an email to the above address during the first week in October and we will see if it is possible to accommodate you.

There will be a conference dinner at Nääs Fabriker on Monday evening, as well as opportunities to use the hotel spa facilities. Presenters will be offered meals and lodging for one night at the conference venue, free of charge. Travel costs are not covered by ASWEDE, however. In order to secure our hotel reservation, deadline for registration will be on October 8.
